USA Cycling and UCI Racing License

- You must show a current USA Cycling or UCI International license to register or pick up your packet.
- Competitor age is determined by the age of the rider on December 31, 2008.
- A local series license or card, or a non-affiliated organization is not a legitimate license.
- It is possible to print "Verification to Race" from www.usacycling.org, the USA Cycling website. This must be done prior to arriving on site as there is no computer available at Athlete Registration.
- Only a beginner or sport may purchase a USA Cycling one-day for \$5.00.
- ANSI or Snell approved helmets required for all events.
- ALL USA Cycling/UCI Rules apply.
- All expert (junior, senior, master), semipro and professional/elite must have a current USA Cycling Annual license.
- You cannot register as a first time competitor as an expert category or above.

Event Registration

- **On-site athlete registration closes at the night prior to the next day's events.** This includes the start of any and all events including preliminary rounds.
There is no race day registration – NO EXCEPTIONS.
- You must include your USA Cycling and/or UCI license number on your NMBS registration form if you want to receive credit for your performance with USA Cycling and/or the UCI. (When the results are sent to the Rankings Manager at USA Cycling, the results are posted based on your license number. This posting is what is used to compute your regional and national ranking. Also this information is what the Regional Manager uses to verify your upgrade status.)
- All participants will sign an event waiver/release form at registration. Those under 18 years old require a parent's or guardian's signature.
- Please verify your start times and other critical event issues when checking in at registration.
- Athlete USA Cycling One-days do not earn ranking and upgrade points.
